

YOUTH MINISTRY

Hello Unity Family! Spring is finally here and I can't wait to see what it holds for us. In January we started off by resetting The Clubhouse and how we work together both in class and outside of class. All together we have been focusing and working out of the Building Community lesson book. So far the kids have looked into topics like; Who am I, Who are We, Working Together. In February the UniTeens/YOU started working on Unity Basics for Life. I am also pleased I finally figured out how I wanted





our Love Offering Wall to work in The Clubhouse. Our Love Offerings are words each youth is encouraged to live by for the week and share to the world around them. Examples of these words are: Love, Kindness, Friendship, Sensitivity and so on. I am hoping that the kids get an understanding that the greatest gift that we can give to those around us is compassion and understanding. Each week the kids are asked to pick a word card, in the same manner a magician would ask you to pick a card, any card. I find that this way it is the universe guiding our youth on what those around them may need, or even an area in their own life that they need to work on and focus on. Once we are finished working on Building Community we will start working out of the Self Images Lesson. This year will be focused on working together and how our own self image is a big part in how we treat ourselves and those around us. Which is also what I am hoping they get from the Love Offering Wall, not only do we need to show those around us compassion and underdering, but we also have to show ourselves as well. PRAYER MINISTRY

Our Prayer Ministry is in a period of transition. Rev. Stevens instituted the Prayer Ministry decades ago so that local people didn't have to pay long-distance rates to call Silent Unity. For many years, it was staffed with a paid Director and staff 7-24. Over time, as call volume decreased, hours of operation were scaled back, ultimately to Monday-Friday, noon to 4 p.m., and the calls were taken remotely from the Prayer Workers' homes.

Rather than do away with the Prayer Ministry altogether, it was decided to make it an all-volunteer operation, with Chaplain volunteers handling the call requests. Now, you can call any time, day, or night, at

619-282-7609 and leave a message requesting prayer. Or send an email to our new email address prayerministryusd@gmail.com. The Chaplains check messages and e-mails three times a day Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will call back to pray with you.

Calls received after 5 p.m. will be returned the next day. Calls and emails received over the weekend will be returned on the following Monday.

Prayer Cards are honored with a letter. When submitting a Prayer Card, if you would like a response by phone or e-mail, please legibly write your contact information on the back of the card.

We want to thank Prayer Minister Director Aline King and all the Prayer workers over the years

for their dedicated service.



"EVERLASTING SERENITY" SPIRITUAL RECOVERY MINISTRY


Please join us on Thursday's at 7pm (PT) on zoom as we learn more ways to put the principles of recovery into action in our daily lives.


