So that we can all stay connected with each other, there are zoom calls for our young people happening every Sunday. For sacred safety reasons we are not including the zoom call links in this information. Southwest Unity Regional Youth & Teen Events Director, Angie Keyes continues to host a Zoom call on Sunday mornings from 11am-12pm for the YOU and UniTeens (ages 12-18) in the southwest region. She has them fully engaged in participating in lessons run by the young people in both large and small groups. C.A.F.E. Grupo - Our Spanish-speaking 12 step family support group will return to meeting at Unity San Diego once restrictions are lifted. They will meet on Friday and Saturday nights from 6:30 -8:30pm on the east side of the second floor. They are anxiously awaiting the lifting of restrictions and their return to Unity San Diego.

We are so fortunate to have so many groups that love meeting at our Spiritual Center. Soon, this quarantine will be behind us and we will all be together again. In the meantime, stay prayed up, centered and safe.
