From the BOARD PRESIDENT'S HEART

As most of you know, **Rev. Sandy**, our transitional minister designee, is unable to come to Unity San Diego due to further hip surgery and recovery time. After much consultation with Unity Worldwide Ministries **Carrie Kenyon** and **Rev. Denese Schellink**, a transitional ministry consultant/minister from Unity of Santa Barbara who had been previously helping us prepare for this transition, we have an alternate plan. The board approved the plan and we are now carrying it out. It includes some staff changes too, which I will address in the Board Letter further in Faith for Today.

Denese will become our new transitional minister, and she will serve us part-time. She was unavailable when we began our transitional process, but that is at the end of September and in the recent process we have realized we really don't need a full-time transitional minister...we think we are good with a part-time one. Denese agrees, and has helped us figure out how to best move forward for Sunday services. The board believes, and Denese concurs, that it is important for congregations to have consistency. At her suggestion to supplement her once-a-month Sunday lesson, we are hiring **Karla Lightner** to do two Sunday services per month. In addition, **Ken Fendrick** and **Rev. Gretchen** will fill in for an additional Sunday per month. We will continue to have guest speakers as we have always done. We are hoping to get **Rev. Richard Rogers** and **Harold Payne** again in the near future and are planning on **Daniel Nahmoud** after the first of the year. If there are other guest speaker suggestions, please see **Karla Lightner** who is now in charge of that. As for ministerial counseling and support, Rev. Denese will be available while she is here, and Rev. Gretchen will be available along with Karla Lightner when she is not available in person or via the internet.

The wonderful thing about our "glitch" and change of plans is that we feel we will be able to get a permanent minister in quicker order than expected. The new direction we are heading in is being helped by the amount of competent people stepping up. We feel sure that Spirit is guiding us in this transition process and we are holding this all in His light!

One of the things we have learned is that some things were not working – it is difficult to move forward for our staff if we are not fully staffed in areas that have been left vacant. After consultation with the board and **Rev. Denese Schellink**, our new transitional minister, the board has developed a plan to remedy that and give the staff the support it needs to carry on. We have created a new position of Operations and Events Manager and **Karla Lightner** is stepping into that position. She had already been filling in with a number of tasks. **Karla** will do Operations and be in charge of special events and have other duties that we are needing to fill. **David Rounsley** will take on some more responsibilities and will be our Facilities Manager. **Cheryl Davis** will be able to do the job we hired her for Volunteer Co-coordinator and Bookstore Manager. **Aline King** has accepted the additional responsibility of handling and organizing the Sunday platform speakers. **Cynthia G.**, our new Administrative Assistant, is helping us to make sure we are in compliance with state laws. **Carol Knudsen** is doing amazing things with all of our graphics, bulletin and FFT and will be helping us expand our internet presence with graphics. **Ron Councell** is stepping up to work with many speakers to make sure our music is as wonderful as it always is. **Dee Laster** is helping re-create our bookstore. **Barbara Mulvaney**, a volunteer in the Youth Ministry, will now become the Youth her cool head who has helped to get us on the road in our process. We have an amazing staff and need to thank them and celebrate their contributions to our church community!

As we move along in our transition process one of the things that has been on the agenda is **Spirit Groups** which is an outgrowth of small groups and will be lead by **Marty (Cowden) Ellingwood**. We will begin this mid-September and are excited to enhance our church community with these groups! It is our hope that we will hire a new full-time permanent minister as soon as it is feasible and we have jumped all the hoops we can to make it happen. Our new minister will be here to give us the ministerial support we need and be a strong leader as we forge our way to becoming the mission centric ministry that is envisioned.
