Here we are starting the beginning of fall season. It is almost six months since many of us have seen each other. I thought this would only last a few months. That has not been our reality. Each week I attended San Diego County's Faith Based Organization's Zoom meetings waiting for a decision. In May, the state and county decided faith communities could resume in-person in-door services within certain guidelines. Our Unity San Diego Board decided to wait until July 5th to see what would occur. Just before our scheduled day to open, the numbers started rising. Our board voted to suspend in-person services due to the rise. Within a few days of our board's meeting, churches were mandated to stop meeting in-person inside until further notice.

Now, here we are; a half of a year without worship in the manner we are accustomed to. I MISS YOU! I have grieved and imagined seeing each of you again. I prayed, asking Spirit to give me ideas for ways to create connection. So, I asked Rev Karla to partner with me to provide a daily prayer and meditation on our church FaceBook page. Now several of us are providing the daily prayer.

When I did not have the physical ability to contact you due to the enormity of our typical work week and all of the meetings, trainings, looking at ways to cut costs and online duties, and shared my grief, sadness and frustration with staff and board, together we formed a team of 21 to call our active members. We call once or twice a month.

Each of us can also look for ways to connect with the indwelling Presence and with each other. We can look at what has been occurring in the past six months as a catalyst for transformation. One of the simplest and most profound ways to connect with God is with the practice of gratitude. While teaching the Absolute Abundance class with the board, we split into pairs so we could share three things with our partner that we were grateful for each day. What we discovered is that life does not seem to be so bleak. Perhaps you could connect with someone from church on a regular basis and talk, text or email three things you are grateful for each day. Sharing gratitude with someone lifts each person's attitude. I pray for Divine connection for everyone.

Please pray with me: "I affirm a continuous attitude of gratitude in all areas of my life."

Each Sunday Unity San Diego's Youth Director, Akosua Washington-Woods and our wonderful Sunday School teacher Tamara Leeper hold a virtual class that teaches Unity Principles to our kids ages 5-10 in fun and exciting ways.

Unity co-founder Myrtle Fillmore emphasized the importance taking care of the children when she said, "Our mission is not to entertain the children, but to call them out. To be always entertained is to be dwarfed and dependent. To be 'called out' is to follow the harmonious law of the soul's unfoldment. Who meddles with the rosebud? What fingers are deft enough to pry open that marvel of folded beauty? We are wise enough to leave it alone to follow the glad law of its own unfolding, but our children! Have we dealt as wisely with these buds of marvelous possibilities? Have we always remembered that they, too, must quicken and unfold through the innate law of their own genius?"

One of the things I think is most successful in our Youth Ministry is the way that Akosua and Tamara use the "Living Curriculum" way of teaching our children. Instead of filling their heads with facts and scriptures to memorize, they "draw out" meaningful portions of each lesson by using stories, experiences and creative expression. This is in line with Myrtle Fillmore's admonition. It is also a fun way to allow each child to go within and form their own unique relationship with the God of their own understanding. What a gift this is to give our Unity children!

In this time of kids and zoom calls, it is truly a challenge to keep our children interested and involved. Akosua and Tamara continue to do a fabulous job and are true blessings to our children.
