We've all continued to face challenges, but we have weathered them well. Despite this, our young people continue to engage, share and prosper. We have continued to welcome our children each Sunday with various lessons, mindfulness activities and a craft relevant to the lesson discussion. 2022 Interfaith Shelter Network News

The Interfaith Shelter Network (ISN) has elected that for the safety of all we are going to host in five hotels this season of 2022. The current cost all-inclusive for hotel for 1 night for 1 household is \$115. A household can be up to 5 individuals. Food costs per individual are \$18/day.

It is not known how many households we can serve because it is all dependent upon funding. Interfaith Shelter Network wants to ensure that our guests have the maximum amount of time to stabilize, meaning about 10-12 weeks.

Generous donations are beginning to arrive for funding for hotel stays, food, and placement housing costs. It is most helpful that any funding sent be with a note in the memo specifying your **Unity Inland Branch** for all needs. This allows the flexibility to utilize it where the greatest need is, be that hotel costs, food costs, or housing placement costs. However, if you wish to direct towards a specific avenue, it will be honored.

11,448 sheltered Bed Nights, 118 Adults, 89 Children, 34,344 meals, 38 individuals went to Transitional Housing, 67 People went to Permanent housing.....50.72% of population transitioned into housing.

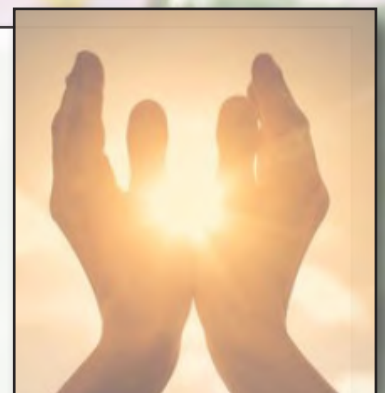
23 gained income. 57 maintained income.

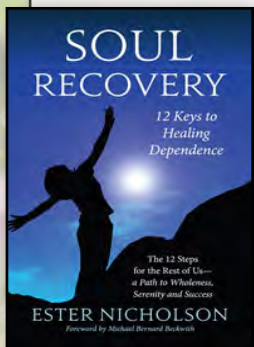

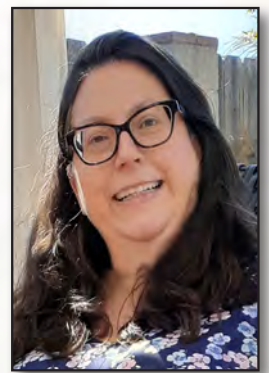
qualifying for these grants has kept our church from depleting its capital reserves due to reduced income.

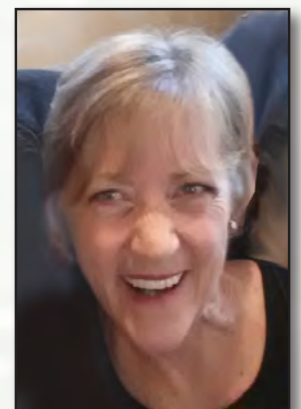

Greetings from the ABC Board!

At the church's recent **Annual Meeting**, some questions arose about ABC's ownership of neighboring properties and the revenue-generating benefit to the church from those properties. Due to the length of the meeting, I thought this might be the best place for sharing or clarifying information with the majority of members, so here goes.

Our church at one time owned the apartment building next door and the two single family residences across the street bordering our large parking lot. Our founding minister, Rev. Bob Stevens, purchased those properties with plans to someday establish a Unity West Seminary, with those units providing housing for the ministerial students and staff; however, that plan never came to fruition. As years passed, to protect the church from potential liability (i.e., the church being pulled into litigation by a tenant), a separate corporation was established to take over ownership and responsibility for these properties.

ABC stands for Altadena Blessing Corporation, a 501c(3) nonprofit California Public Benefits Corporation set up by the church to take over their ownership. At that time, the corporation's mission was clearly set forth to provide "affordable housing" (not "low income" housing) for our region, through these and potentially other future properties. In essence, we're carrying out the church's mission of community service.

There was never a stipulation that ABC financially support Christ Church Unity/Unity San Diego – indeed, to do so would jeopardize our tax-exempt status. Our mission is to provide and maintain more affordable housing. However, upon receipt of a monthly written request, ABC has provided \$4,000 per month to support our church, and \$6,000 per month in 2020. We have, on many occasions over the years, also provided all or matching funds for various Wish-List needs of the church.

In the past, our board members were required to be active members of Unity San Diego, as all current members are, but we have in recent years changed the by-laws to allow us to welcome other community members who have experience and expertise in areas that will benefit our work and mission fulfillment.

We are currently obtaining bids related to a potential property purchase for development, and will keep you informed as things unfold.
